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APPLICABILITY:

Available in all territory served to Members of the Cooperative for service to irrigation pump uses, subject to its established rules and regulations.

TERRITORY:

All electric residential and commercial consumers served by RCEC in Roosevelt County and extending into portions of Curry, Lea, Chaves and De Baca counties.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, three-phase, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltage.

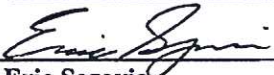
TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of advalorem, state, and federal income taxes) payable by the utility and levied or assessed by any government authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or any other object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

IDLE SERVICE RATE:

Consumers classified under this rate schedule may retain existing electric facilities (disconnected) on their premises by paying 60% of the established monthly minimum bill each month thereafter.

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MINIMUM CHARGES:

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The annual minimum charge for the period ending December 31, 2026, under this schedule shall be \$22.50/HP/Year, but not less than \$225.00 per year. Beginning January 1, 2027, the minimum annual charge shall be the Annual Horsepower Charge per connected horsepower or fraction thereof, plus all billing adjustments.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule shall be increased or decreased by any amount that the purchased power cost for the previous month differs from \$.069665/KWH sold, in accordance with NMPRC Rule No. 550.

DISTRIBUTED GENERATION (DG) NET METERING RATE RIDER:

Billings under this rate rider shall have the following charges

Billing/Meter Reading Cost	\$4.51 per month
Facilities Charge (per DG System Nameplate KW)	\$5.72 per KW

SURCHARGE:

Billing under this schedule shall have a surcharge of 1% in order to procure renewable energy, invest in renewable energy projects or promote energy conservation and load management.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

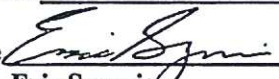
All bills under this rate are due and payable when rendered and become delinquent twenty (20) calendar days after the billing date.

DETERMINATION OF HORSEPOWER:

The horsepower for billing purposes shall be the motor manufacturer's nameplate rating of horsepower output. If the Cooperative so elects, the horsepower shall be determined by actual measurements of power input during a period of maximum normal use.

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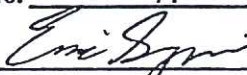
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HORSEPOWER CHARGE:

X

1. The Horsepower Charge for services connected for the full year or for a portion of the year will be billed as follows, unless there is a contractual agreement obligating the customer to additional charges.
 - Services connected prior to the current year and remains connected through the May billing cycle: The horsepower charge will be billed monthly in the January through May billing cycle.
 - New services connected after the January billing cycle and before September 1st: The full amount of the horsepower charge will be billed in five equal payments in the first five months connected.
 - Existing services connected after the January billing cycle and before September 1st: The full amount of the horsepower charge will be billed in five equal payments in the first five months connected.
 - Services connected in the September billing cycle will be billed in September for one month of horsepower charges in the billing month of September.
 - Services connected in October, November or December: There will not be a horsepower charge for the current year.
2. Irrigation services disconnected during the year will be billed the annual horsepower charge as follows:
 - Services disconnected before or during the February billing cycle: There will be no additional horsepower charges for the current year provided the service is not reconnected during the remainder of the year. Reconnected services will be billed for horsepower charges avoided while the service was disconnected. (Horsepower charges avoided are charges that would have been billed to the customer if the customer had been receiving service in the March through August billing periods.)

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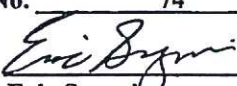
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- Services disconnected during the March billing cycle: A monthly horsepower charge will be billed in the March billing cycle provided there is usage during that cycle. If there is no usage, there will be no horsepower charge for that cycle and no additional horsepower charge for that year unless the service is reconnected during the same year. Services reconnected will be billed for any horsepower charges avoided while the service was disconnected.
 - Services disconnected after the March billing cycle: A service disconnected following the March billing cycle with usage in that cycle will be billed the current month horsepower charge, no prior months' horsepower charges will be refunded. If a service is disconnected after the March billing cycle and there is no usage in that cycle, there will be no additional horsepower charges. Services reconnected in the same year will be billed for any of the horsepower charges avoided while the service was disconnected.
 - Service disconnected between June and December billing cycles: Services disconnected in this time period will not be eligible for any refund of the billed horsepower charges.
3. Services transferred from one customer to another in January through May billing cycle: The monthly billing of the horsepower charge will be prorated for each customer/member based on the date of transfer during that billing cycle.

CHANGE IN IRRIGATION HORSEPOWER:

Customers/Members should notify the Cooperative as soon as possible when changing a well to a different horsepower. The adjustment will go into effect at the time the Cooperative is notified verified by the Cooperative. Adjustments to the horsepower charges will not be reduced if there is a contractual agreement obligating the customer to a higher amount. Customers/Members shall give written notice to the Cooperative fifteen (15) days in advance of increasing horsepower load above the rated capacity of transformer(s) serving Customer/Member. If Customer/Member fails to give such notice and an overload condition causes damage to the transformer(s) serving Customer/Member, then Customer/Member shall pay to the Cooperative the replacement cost of the transformer plus all additional costs involved for replacement.

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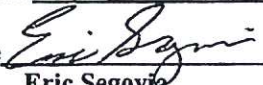
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1. Horsepower decreases will be billed as follows:
 - Irrigation horsepower decreased from January through March billing cycles: Irrigation wells with decreased horsepower will be at the lower rate beginning in the month notification is given to the Cooperative. There will be no adjustments for previously billed horsepower charges.
 - Irrigation horsepower decreased after the March billing cycle: No adjustment will be made to the annual horsepower charges previously billed.
2. Horsepower increases will be billed as follows:
 - Irrigation horsepower increased before the end of the March billing cycle: The service will be charged at the increased annual horsepower rate for all billing cycles beginning in March.
 - Irrigation horsepower increased in April through August: There will be an adjustment to any previously billed horsepower charges for that year based on the increased horsepower rate. Any annual horsepower charges not yet billed will also be billed using the new horsepower.
 - Irrigation horsepower increased in September through December: There will be no additional charges or adjustments for the current year.

CONNECT AND RECONNECT – AVOIDED MONTHLY CUSTOMER CHARGES:
Customer disconnecting and reconnecting an irrigation service within a 12 month period will be billed avoided monthly Customer Charge billing.

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
