NON-MEMBER CONSUMER EASEMENT SURCHARGE

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APPLICABILITY:

All non-member consumers receiving electric service from Roosevelt County Electric Cooperative (RCEC) that have received compensation from RCEC for easements being served under the following rates: 1-General Service, 2-Commercial Service, 3-Irrigation and Dryer Service, 4-Demand Energy, 5-Lighting, or 8-Oil Well Pumping.

MONTHLY RATE FOR EACH ELECTRIC SERVICE:

Highest easement payment made to non-member consumer per rod (16.5 feet), times the number of rods of power lines owned by RCEC, divided by the number of meters served by RCEC at the beginning of each calendar year, divided by the number of months in contract for electric service (if there is no line extension contract between Consumer and Cooperative 60 months will be assumed)

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, state, and federal income taxes) payable by the utility and levied or assessed by any government authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or any other object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Cooperative's filed rules apply to service under this schedule.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills under this rate are due and payable when rendered, and become delinquent twenty (20) calendar days after the billing date.
